TOUR OVERVIEW

Day 1 | April 1 | 2026

- Depart Harare on overnight flight to Ireland.

Day 2 | April 2 | 2026

- Mid-Morning: Flight arrives in into Dublin Airport. Met by your SA Sports Tours representative and brought to your bus.
- You will head into Dublin City and do a walking tour of the city centre. This two-hour tour will help the group acclimatise themselves with Dublin and allow them the opportunity to see some sights themselves during their free time later in the week.
- Once the tour is over the group will have some time to get lunch. After lunch you will meet up at designated time and head to the hotel to check in.
- After check in we will go to a local hockey field for a self-led training session.
- Evening: Dinner in a local restaurant or hotel.

Day 3 | April 3 | 2026

- Breakfast in the hotel.
- After breakfast you will depart for **match 1 v a local team**.
- After match social with the Irish players.
- Afternoon: Attend a prominent local fixture. Exact fixture to be confirmed nearer the time.
- Evening: Dinner in a local restaurant or hotel.

Day 4 | April 4 | 2026

- Breakfast in the hotel.
- After breakfast we will check out of our accommodation. The group will have some free time in Dublin before we depart for Cork in the early afternoon.
- On route from Dublin to Cork we will stop at the Rock of Cashel to visit the world-famous fortress which dates back to the 10th century.
- After the Rock we will continue onto Cork and once in Cork we will check into our accommodation.
- After check in we will go to a local hockey field for a self-led training session.
- Evening: Dinner in a local restaurant or hotel.

Day 5 | April 5 | 2026

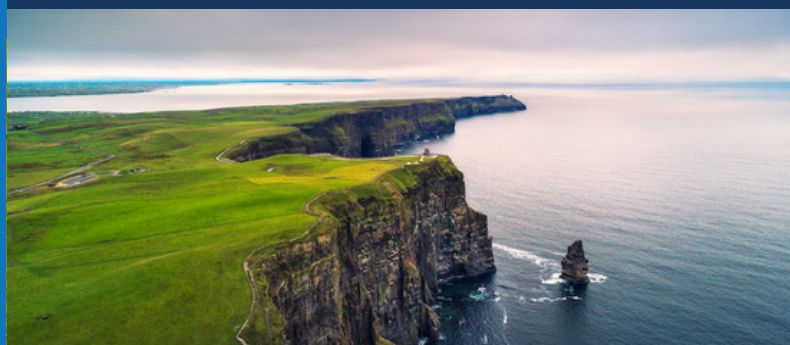
- Breakfast in the hotel.
- Mid-Morning: Some free time in Cork City.
- Afternoon: After match social with the Irish players.

Day 6 | April 6 | 2026

- Breakfast in the hotel.
- After breakfast we will depart for a day's activity of a visit to The Blarney Castle and Gardens to kiss the Blarney Stone. The current stone structure dates back to 1446 and is one of the finest examples of a medieval stronghold in Ireland.
- After Blarney the group will have some free time for lunch, after lunch we will visit to the port town of Cobh the last stop for the Titanic and a visit to the Titanic Museum to find out the amazing history of the Titanic's links with the town.
- After the Titanic tour we will go to a local hockey ground for a training session.
- Evening: Dinner in a local restaurant or hotel.

Day 7 | April 7 | 2026

- Breakfast in the hotel.
- Some free time in Cork city in the morning.
- We will depart for Limerick and in the afternoon play match 3 v local teams. After match social with the Irish players.
- After the matches we will go to our hotel to check in.
- Evening: Dinner in a local restaurant or hotel.



Day 8 | April 8 | 2026

- Breakfast in the hotel.
- We will go to the Cliffs of Moher for a tour of the cliffs and the surrounding areas. This tour will take the whole day.
- Evening: Dinner in a local restaurant or hotel.

Day 9 | April 9 | 2026

- Breakfast in the hotel.
- After breakfast we will check out of the hotel and make our way back to Dublin. Once in Dublin we will go to play match 4 v local opposition. After match social with the Irish players.
- After the matches we will go to our hotel to check in.
- Evening: Dinner in a local restaurant or hotel.
