

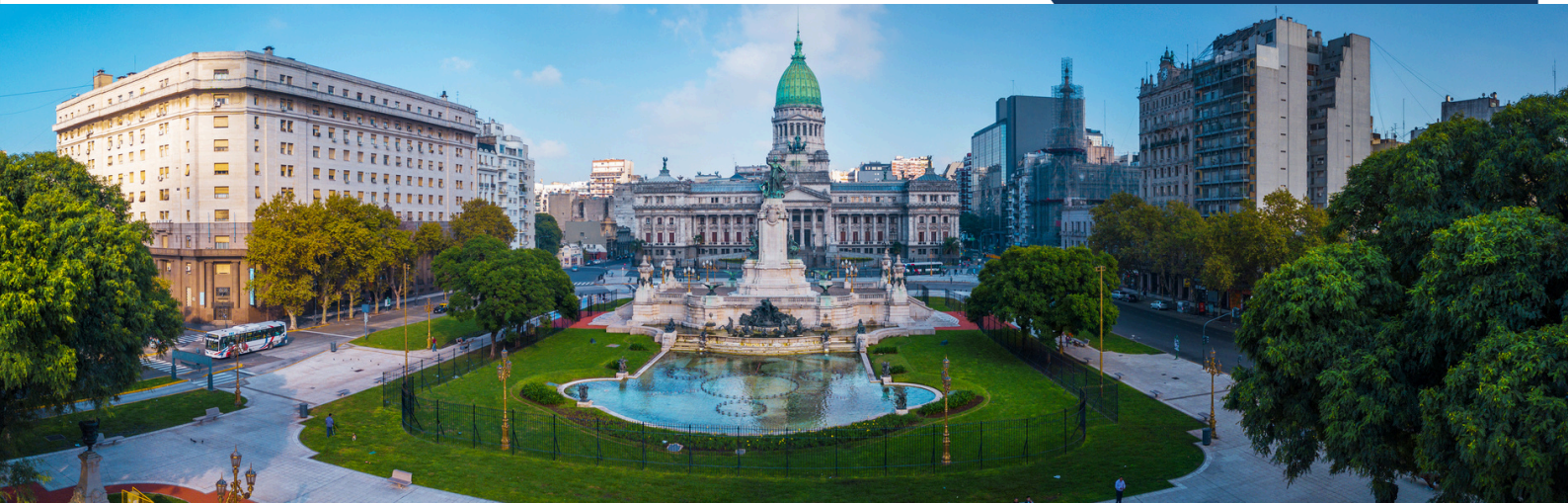

TOUR OVERVIEW

Day 1: JHB to Buenos Aires

- The group departs Johannesburg. Depart on the international flight via Sao Paulo to Buenos Aires.

Day 2: Buenos Aires

- The group checks in very early hours of the morning.
- Morning at leisure to rest after long haul travel.
- Afternoon the team has the opportunity to acclimatise with a self led training session at a local AstroTurf facility.
- Group returns to the Hotel to freshen up for dinner
- Dinner at a local restaurant or the hotel (TBC)

Day 3: Buenos Aires

- After breakfast the group departs on a guided city tour of Buenos Aires. Points of interest while on tour are, Caminito | Mafalda Statue | Estadio Alberto J.Armando (La Bombonera) | Avenida de Mayo | Puerto Madero | Casa Rosada | El Ateneo Grand Splendid | Floralis Genérica.
- The afternoon is reserved for the first fixture of the tour against a local club team.
- The group enjoys an after-match dinner/social.

Day 4: Buenos Aires

- Today after breakfast the group enjoys a full day in Buenos Aires and a visit to Tigre and the Delta with a boat trip arranged for the group (The boat trip entails the following: You will navigate the five main rivers that form the lower Paraná Delta, where its imposing beauty is touched by orcher and green hues. We'll see the canals outlined by nature, the traditional rowing clubs, the Tigre Art Museum, the Port of Fruits and the islanders' particular lifestyle. The whole activity will be accompanied by an expert professional bilingual guide.
- The afternoon is enjoyed at the Parque de la Costa theme park and entertainment park. The Gold passport for rides and games has been included in the tour to ensure the group does not waste any time waiting to get into the park and ensuring maximum fun during the visit.
- The group then returns by bus to their hotel for dinner

Day 5: Buenos Aires

- group enjoys breakfast at the Hotel
- The group departs to visit the Bacigaluppo Foundation. The foundation provides sporting opportunities to individuals with intellectual disabilities.
- The afternoon the teams will play their 2nd fixture against a local club in Buenos Aires at the clubs local grounds.
- An after match social is arranged for dinner and interaction with the opposition.
- The group then returns to the Hotel

Day 6: Buenos Aires to Rosario

- Breakfast included at the Hotel.
- The group checks out and departs by bus for the tour to Rosario. The trip takes approximately 4 hours.
- Lunch is enjoyed en-route or once the group arrives in Rosario.
- Check into the Hotel
- Hockey fixtures are arranged in the afternoon for the touring teams vs a local club, a after match function and dinner is also arranged with the opposition.
- Return to the Hotel

Day 7: Rosario

- Breakfast included at the Hotel.
- The group to pack all their sports gear before departing the Hotel.
- The group has the opportunity to explore the city centre with their Tour Manager during the morning.
- Lunch enjoyed at a local eatery or street vendors in Rosario.
- Fixtures vs local teams for the touring sides are arranged.
- After match function and dinner is also arranged with the opposition.
- Return to the Hotel



Day 8: Rosario to Buenos Aires

- Breakfast included at the Hotel.
- The group checks out to depart for Buenos Aires again.
- The group does have an opportunity to stop at the Estancia Gaucho Ranch close to Buenos Aires to experience a Argentinian Horse ranch and farm. It is a fantastic cultural experience for any group visiting Argentina.
- Late check in at the Hotel and dinner at a local restaurant / Eatery (TBC)

Day 9: Buenos Aires

- Breakfast included at the Hotel.
- An effort is being made to get the touring sides into mini festivals (This is subject to the age group league fixtures being confirmed which is at the end of February)

HOTEL INFORMATION

BUENOS AIRES - El Conquistador Hotel (8 nights)

Only 100 metres from 9 de Julio Avenue, El Conquistador Hotel offers rooms with free WiFi. A fitness centre and a rooftop restaurant are featured. Galerías Pacifico Mall is 500 metres away. Parque de la Costa

Take an easy half-day trip from Buenos Aires to the Tigre Delta. Enjoy a scenic cruise around this unique suburb, built around the swampy land and meandering waterways that empty from the Rio Paraná into the Rio de la Plata.
